



## Year 10 Options for 2017/18

Please choose one subject from each option block below by circling or highlighting the choices. All students should choose at least two science subjects (from Physics, Chemistry and Biology), at least one humanities subject (from Geography and History) and at least one vocational subject (from Business Studies, Art, Music or P.E.) as well as either French or Swahili.

160 minutes per week is allocated to each option. In addition to these options all students in year 10 study 200 minutes of maths per week, 200 minutes of English, 80 minutes of ICT, 60 minutes of PE, 40 minutes of Citizenship and PSHE.

It is important to make the right choices as no further changes can be made once the year begins. Subjects may only be 'dropped' after the mock exams if it is considered to be the most beneficial decision for the child and only with the consent of the parents.

IGCSE examinations (administered by the Cambridge International Examinations Board) are sat at the end of Year 11. Most students will sit for 9 or 10 subjects: Mathematics, English Language, ICT as well as the 6 option choices plus English Literature for those that we think are capable of gaining a passing grade in the subject.
